Methodology: Crypto industry contributions to Ways & Means committee members were compiled through a manual review of (1) donation receipts reflecting contributions to a committee member's principal campaign committee or to a joint fundraising Political Action Committee (PAC) of which the committee member's principal campaign committee is listed as a participant during the 2024 or 2026 election cycle¹ as well as (2) independent expenditures on a committee member during the 2024 or 2026 election cycle,² all of which is publicly available on the Federal Election Commission website. For the purposes of this analysis, "crypto industry contributions" as described herein refers to monetary contributions by individuals or PACs affiliated with crypto companies as well as individuals or companies that have prominently backed the crypto industry.

Our investigation identified contributions from individuals and PACs affiliated with the industry-associated organizations listed below as well as independent expenditures from the super PACs listed below. Organizations not listed here may have interests in cryptocurrency policy, so the findings of this report should be read as an 'identified minimum' of each the amount each candidate has received from the cryptocurrency industry, rather than an exhaustive list.
